Description of *College BASE* Standard Scoring Options

The scoring prices for all standard options, except when scoring the essay only, include one institutional summary report and two score reports per student: one copy is sent to the institution, and one copy is sent to the student. Only an administration roster with raw scores is provided when only essays are scored.

Complete a separate *Order Form for Standard Scoring Options* for each test administration. A minimum order requires a total invoice value of at least \$180.00.

Standard Scoring Option	Description of Standard Scoring Options
Same Subject(s) Option	Students must all take the same assigned subject(s). This option is useful when you need campus effectiveness information for curriculum review, when individual student scores are desired, and for obtaining value-added data. Institutions may administer four or three subjects, with or without the essay assignment, or may administer any one of the four subjects alone. Students must all use the same <i>College BASE</i> test form. Please call the <i>College BASE</i> coordinator at 1-800-366-8232 to discuss any other scoring options.
<i>College BASE 1:1</i> Option (Short Form)	When assessment time is limited, institutions may administer one or two multiple-choice subjects per student, spiraled to provide four-subject results. See the <i>Manual for Test Coordinators and Examiners Supplement, Administration of College BASE 1:1</i> for important information regarding selection of a sample of students and random assignment of subject(s).
Basic Skills Option	This option provides for individual student assessment of basic skills, including English math, and/or writing. Students within one administration may take different combinations of the three skill areas. Only one test form may be used during any single administration. This option is useful as a general education admissions requirement for upper-level professional classes, such as teacher preparation. If essay assessment is desired, students may be assigned writing only as a basic skills option.
