

Missouri Kindergarten Inventory of Developmental Skills (KIDS)

The Missouri Kindergarten Inventory of Developmental Skills (KIDS) is a screening battery developed by a State Task Force on Early Childhood Screening. It is designed for ages four to six. A parent/guardian questionnaire is included in order to obtain additional relevant information about each child's development. The following areas of development are surveyed:

- Number Concepts
- Language Concepts
- Auditory Skills
- Visual Skills
- Paper and Pencil Skills
- Gross Motor Skills

The total administration time is approximately 35 minutes.

NOTE: The Missouri Kindergarten Inventory of Developmental Skills (KIDS) is hand-scored by the kindergarten teacher.

Alternate Edition Materials

The Alternate Edition (1982) is appropriate for children 48–72 months and can be given any time within the year preceding kindergarten, as well as at kindergarten entrance.
