	E-3	Skill oriented, "hands on," such as art studio, social-work field experience.
	F-3	Discussion sections. Emphasis on classroom interaction, explanations.
	G-3	Lecture courses which strongly emphasize textbook and homework problems, such as math.
	H-3	Laboratory instruction. Emphasis on preparedness, organization, safety, interest level.
